WRITER'S DIGEST EDITOR AMY JONES AND AWARD-WINNING AUTHOR NICOLE GIVENS KURTZ TO KEYNOTE WRITE NOW! 2024

Raleigh, N.C. – **Triangle Association of Freelancers (TAF)** is proud to announce that *Writer's Digest* Editor-in-Chief Amy Jones and award-winning science fiction author Nicole Givens Kurtz will keynote Write Now! 2024, TAF's 14th annual spring writing symposium.

The conference will be held on Saturday, April 27, 2024, at The McKimmon Conference & Training Center at North Carolina State University, 1101 Gorman Street, in Raleigh. Doors will open at 8 a.m. and the conference will begin with Nicole Givens Kurtz' opening address at 9 a.m. The event will conclude at 4 p.m.

Amy Jones is the Editor-in-Chief of *Writer's Digest* and was the managing content director for WD Books. She is the editor of the *Novel and Short Story Writer's Market* and *Children's Writer's and Illustrator's Market*. Prior to joining the WD team, Amy was the managing editor for North Light Books and IMPACT Books. Like most WD staffers, Amy is a voracious reader and has a particular interest in literary fiction, historical fiction, steamy romance, and page-turning mysteries. Her keynote address is entitled **"Plot Twist: How Not to Land Your Dream Job."** In addition to her keynote, Amy will present a session on how to catch and keep an editor's attention.

Nicole Givens Kurtz has been called "a genre polymath who does crime, horror, and SFF" by *Book Riot*, which named her one of the 6 Black SFF Indie Writers You Should be Reading. With over 20 years in publishing, she has published more than 50 short stories and is the author of the *Cybil Lewis and Death Violations* Cyber Noir series as well as the *Kingdom of Aves* fantasy mystery series. Her keynote, **"When Everything Feels Terrible, Create,"** covers the importance of creativity in today's writing environment. Givens Kurtz will also present a session on the art of short story writing.

Additional conference presenters include veteran freelancer **Don Vaughan**, who will explore how writers can turn life experience into article ideas; editor and writing instructor **Kyle Marie McMahon** on how to use your personal memories to create a memoir; award-winning romance author **Reese Ryan** on crafting supporting characters; longtime GQ correspondent **Sean Flynn** on the elements of a successful interview; publisher **Karin Wiberg** presents a self-publishing how-to; and editor **Laura Poole** explains how to get the most out of a style manual.
